

INTERNATIONAL INTERNAL COMMISSION
IPA WORLD POLICE PRIZE – AWARD PROCEDURE

1. The IPA World Police Prize may be awarded to any individual or organisation for exceptional services rendered to the police service; to the IPA; **or for the benefit of society on matters of human rights or the preservation of World Peace.**
2. The prize will be 10 000.- CHF (Swiss Francs).
3. The prize shall be accompanied by a certificate, which shall be in English, together with an appropriate cup, plate, plaque or the like, which shall include the IPA logo.
4. Nominations may be put forward by Sections or by individuals.
5. Full details of the nominee should be submitted in writing to the International Secretary General no later than the last day of February for consideration that year, and supported with such documentary material as may be considered necessary.
6. All submissions will be passed to the appropriate International Commission for processing, which in turn will pass its recommendation to the PEB. The PEB shall make the final decision.
7. There shall be a maximum of one prize awarded per year. Any prize awarded will be formally announced at the IPA World Congress or IEC Conference and presented at the same time or at such other time and location as the PEB shall decide.
