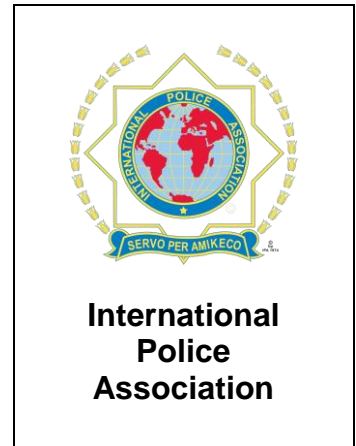

Arrival in Bucharest: For the information of participants, the Organising Committee has said that everyone will be met at both airports, railway station etc. At the Henri Conada Airport, to the right, after leaving the arrivals hall, an IPA reception desk will be seen, with members of the Romanian Organising Committee in uniform, to direct participants to the buses for transfer to the hotel. At the hotel a Registration Reception will be available where participants will receive all relevant documents and information.

Social Programme: We have been told that there will be no social programme for those who did not pay for the optional programmes. However, participants may inform the Organising Committee on arrival if they wish to join these programmes and pay the fee (130 Euro).

Visas: For those who were unable to obtain a visa for whatever reason, there will be an opportunity at the airport at a special office, to get a visa on request.
