

we had the legal powers to deprive a person of their liberty and bring them before a court. We, regardless of administrative rank all had the same powers. The Commissioner (Chief of Police) had no more power than the most junior of probationary constables out on the street which to some degree is a bit of a leveller.

I'm prepared to start the ball rolling, (in future issues), by recounting my time and experiences of serving in the London Metropolitan Police and hopefully it will prompt others to open up and tell their stories for publication in the Killroomer
