### Section in Foundation Status

---

- i) This was granted to the **IPA Founding Committee of Moldova**. Membership is growing rapidly and they are proving to be a progressive Section in the making. Section Romania as sponsors are to be congratulated too for the assistance they give to them.
- ii) Unfortunately the decision was made to withdraw the status from Macau, as there had been little improvement over the last two years.

### Bosnia and Herzegovina

### International Levy

In 2008 levy was received by the International Treasurer for 369,737 members.

## Organisation of American States (OAS).

---

We are pleased to inform you that the Permanent Council of OAS at its meeting held on April 1 2009, approved the registration of the International Police Association to be included as a registered civil society organisation in the OAS.

Hugh Brien is our ERC representative to the Organisation of American States in Washington and has already attended their Civil Society Hemispheric Forum (NGO) in Washington, DC in March 2009. Thirty countries from South /Central America and Mexico participated.

We look forward to continued liaison with this organisation.

## International workshop invitation - "Young police forces in Europe without inner borders".

This workshop is being held from 31<sup>st</sup> May to 6 June 2009 in Prague and is open to all National Sections.

In support of this project, the IPA President of the Netherlands, Kees Sal, has asked that Sections be encouraged to each send two young police officers to make this Czech Republic initiative a success. ## **IPA Workshop Report on Children as victims IEC Conference Moscow 2008**

60 National IPA Sections, from all continents, divided into 8 groups discussed the subject of **Children as Victims**. Each group submitted a report on their discussions. Several reports include a description of the situation in the various countries and it is hoped that the findings will be of interest to the police service everywhere. Therefore the results are published here.

The various group reports attached to this introduction are only available in the language in which they were produced.

### **Introduction:**

The participants listed a great variety of types of crime against children experienced in their countries: From children being forced to being soldiers, beggars, thieves, prostitutes, to child pornography on the internet, paedophilia, domestic violence, school violence and mobbing. The definition of a child in respect of the age varies from country to country (up to 14, 15 and 18 years were mentioned).

The discussions revealed no lack of national legislation when it comes to investigating this type of crime.

However, some difficulties were mentioned, such as:

- limits in the possibilities of exchanging information across borders (data protection),
- limited resources (including technical) to investigate crime (pornography) on the internet and
- limited access to phone tapping in these types of crime.

Conversely, good police methods in prevention and investigating this type of crime were put forward and other possibilities recommended:

- Cross territorial police cooperation. Cross border cooperation, especially re child pornography
- Crime prevention including use of the internet
- Close police cooperation with other authorities (social workers, teachers, etc.)
